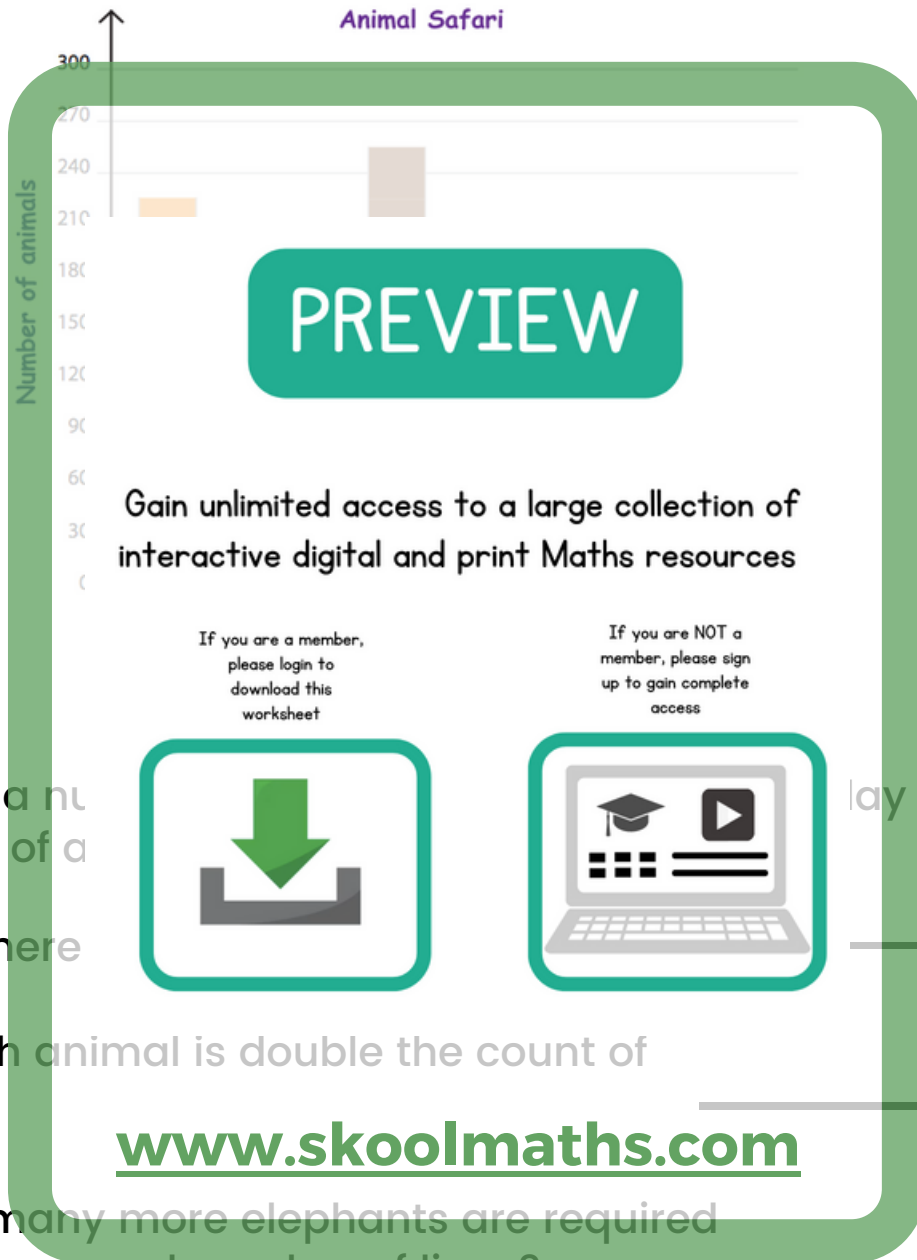

3) Which animal is double the count of Giraffe?

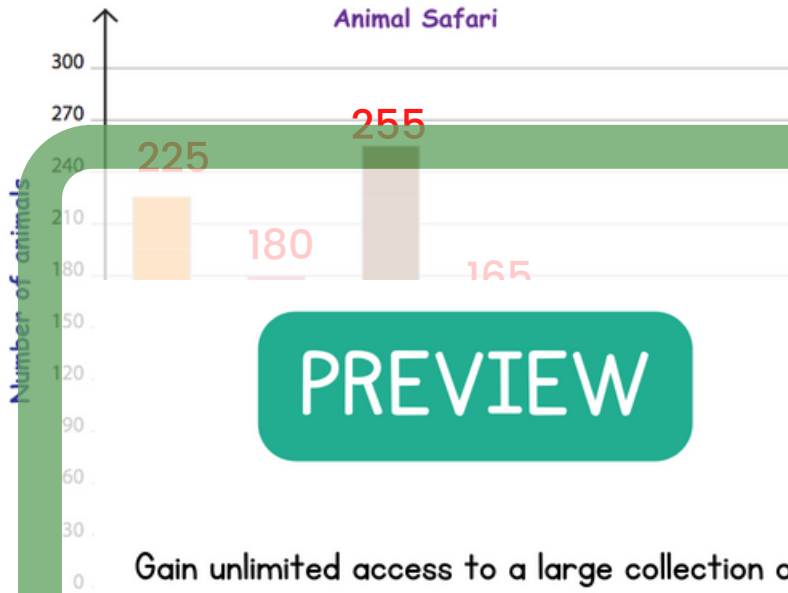
4) How many more elephants are required to have an equal number of lions?
