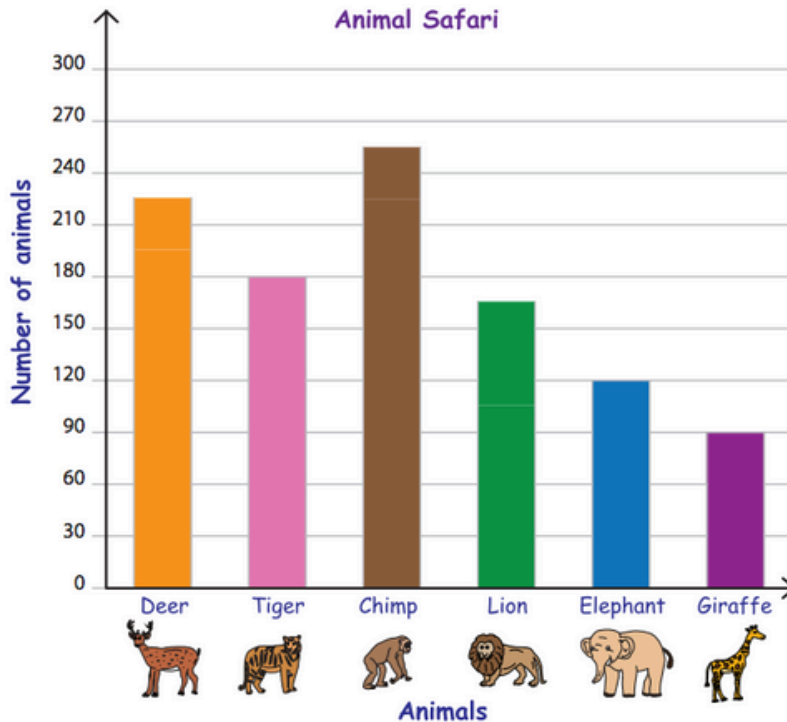

2) Are there more Chimps or Deer? \_\_\_\_\_

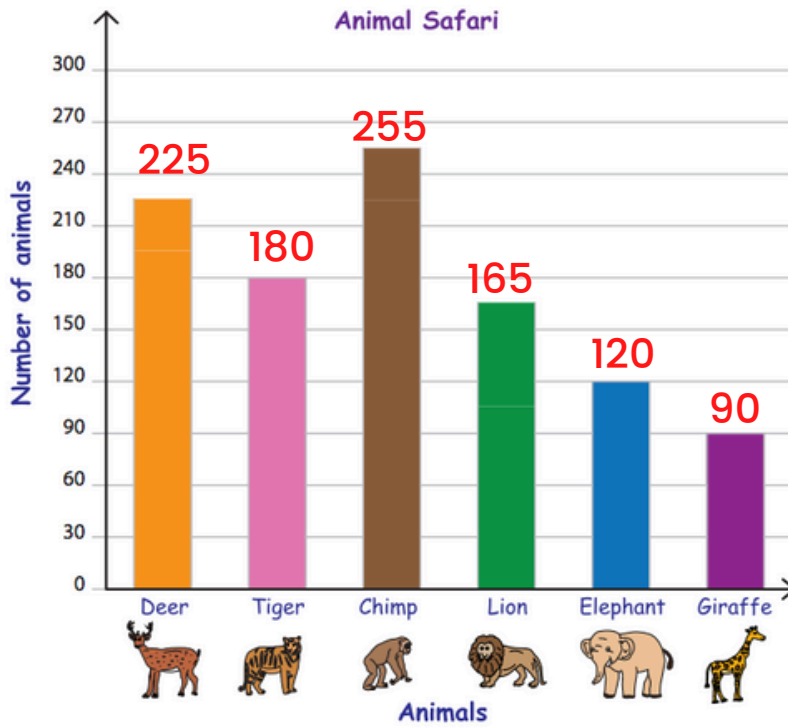
