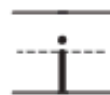

In dot to dot, your job is this:

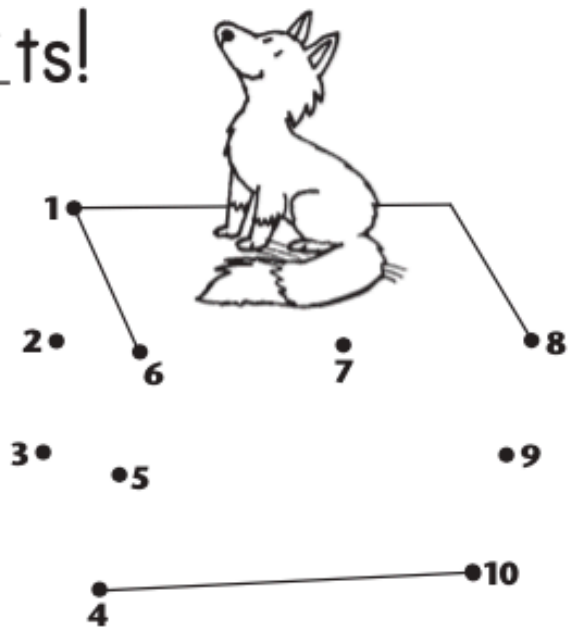
Hop from dot to dot.
